

BATTLE PLAN AGAINST THE ENEMY!

1. Know your weaknesses! The enemy knows them and he will always strike where he was successful the last time.
2. Make a list of regular negative thought patterns that run through your mind and/ or areas of sin that you struggle with. Refuse to entertain them! (ie. I will never be able to.... I am so stupid, clumsy etc.)
3. Look up scripture that is the exact opposite of what your negative thought patterns are or sin issues and make scripture cards you can carry with you and post around your house. (If you need help with this, just let us know)
4. Speak those scriptures out boldly and loudly every time you see them or at least 3 times a day!
5. Ask God to cover any open doors you may have to the enemy with the blood of Jesus until you are aware of them or able to deal with them. (one giant at a time)
6. **Pray in your prayer language daily and often!** (If you don't have one, come see us even if you have already been baptized with the Holy Spirit)
7. Walk in forgiveness! If you won't choose to forgive those who have wronged you or hurt you and let God deal with them, none of this will work and you will have a HUGE open door to the enemy!
8. Ask God to forgive the sins of your ancestors and declare that you forgive them as well and ask that any curses or occult powers associated with them would be broken over your, your spouse and children, if applicable, as well as future generations. (You don't have to know what your ancestors did wrong- God already does- but you don't want open doors from them either! The Bible say that the sins of the fathers are passed down to the 3rd and 4th generation.)
9. Just lay down your pride! God RESISTS the proud but gives grace to the humble! Pride will keep you in bondage!
10. Be careful what you are watching and listening to! Your eyes and ears act as spiritual gates to your soul!
11. Guard your words! If you speak out something that is not positive or does not line up with the Word of God, be quick ask God to forgive you and say "I cast those words to the ground and render them ineffective forevermore by the blood of the Lamb"! Then speak a blessing instead! (ie. "I am just drowning in debt." Cast those words down and replace with "I thank God that He supplies all my needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus!")
12. Make up your mind to keep speaking the Word no matter what your circumstances are! Circumstances will change as your faith is built up and your words are in agreement with THE WORD! This takes time!
13. If you are under a particularly difficult attack, get help! Ask someone to agree with you in prayer! Where one can put a thousand to fight, two can put 10,000 to flight!
14. Remember, the enemy will see you as you see yourself! If you see yourself as a mighty conquerer like the Word says you are, so will he! If you see yourself as weak and vulnerable, so will he!
15. Remember fighting the good fight is not an option! Choosing not to fight will not keep the enemy from striking you! You might as well learn to be victorious!
